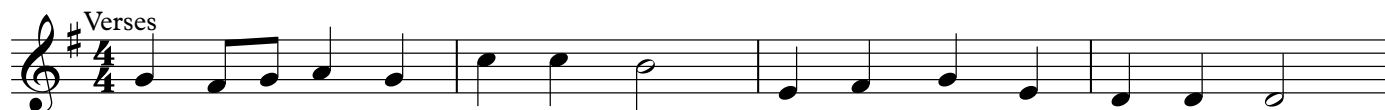


# Where the River Meets the Sea
